

# EECS 395: Development for Mobile Devices

## Final Project Writeup

Along with the code for your final project, you will also turn in a Final Project Write-up. They are both due during our Final Exam time, Wednesday, June 10, from 7-10 p.m. Along with the proposal you already turned in, this document will constitute 10% of your final grade.

In the final writeup, I am looking for N things:

### **Your name and app title**

**App Store Description:** This is the description that people will/would see when browsing your app on Apple's App Store. This means that your description should convince people to try or buy your app. Be honest, of course, but also make the case for why your app is worth trying. Look at other successful apps on the App Store to get ideas.

**Screenshots:** Apple requires that you submit a few screenshots of your app so that customers can see what it looks like. Include a few screenshots of your app that show it favorably. (You can use Command-Shift-4 on your Mac, then draw a box around your app to get a screenshot.) The screenshot should just be the app itself, not the simulator.

**Proud parent:** Give me a sentence or two about what part of your app you are proudest of.

**Could've been a contender:** Things get very hectic at the end of the quarter, features get dropped, etc. I want a sentence or two each on what

you would've liked to do with your app if you had another week, another month, and another three months.

**Course suggestions:** This is totally unrelated to the final project, but I'm eager for feedback for the course. I would especially appreciate any suggestions you have, either for offering this course again next year, or my teaching style in general. These suggestions aren't anonymous of course, but I won't read them before giving out the final grades. Please give me at least one suggestion.
